

### CLIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

1. You have right to expect that a therapist has met the minimal qualifications of training and experience required by state law;
2. You have right to examine public records maintained by the Board of Marriage and Family Therapy which contain the credentials of a therapist;
3. You have right to obtain a copy of the code of ethics from the State Register and Public Documents Division, Department of Administration, 117 University Avenue, Saint Paul, MN 55155;
4. You have right to report complaints to the Board of Marriage and Family Therapy, University Park Plaza Building, 2829 University Avenue SE, Suite 330, Minneapolis, MN 55414-3222;
5. You have right to be informed of the cost of professional services before receiving the services;
6. You have right to privacy as defined by rule and law;
7. You have right to be free from being the object of discrimination on the basis of race, religion, gender, or other unlawful category while receiving services;
8. You have right to have access to your records as provided in Minnesota Statutes, section [144.292](#); and
9. You have right to be free from exploitation for the benefit or advantage of a therapist.
